The National Open Art Competition started the beginning of the year with a stand at the prestigious Watercolours + Works on Paper Art Fair at the Science Museum in London. The Fair was started in 1986 and has evolved over the years becoming one of the most popular, and high profile art fairs in the art calendar. The earliest works on offer were from the late 15th century, and the most recent were completed on site by the artist in Residence, Leonie Lachlan from the Prince's Drawing School.

We are delighted to have been invited by the organisers; Works on Paper Fair Ltd who are based near Petworth, to exhibit 10 artworks from the National Open Art Exhibition 2010 these were showcased at the fair; which attracts over 11,000 visitors.
