SEVEN hits Brighton Fringe for the very first time! A brand new performance created by a brand new artist collective.

SEVEN is a verbatim performance piece where actors and projected film combine to create an immersive experience. In **SEVEN** actors listen to real recorded conversation and simultaneously repeat the testimony as precisely as possible, preserving the characters vocal tics, repetition, pauses and illogicality. Working with veterans and their partners the themes explored in this performance are that of shared ordeal, love and loss.

These fragments of real memory become physically translated when the actors push their bodies and minds through punishing method acting exercises; here the anonymous voice becomes a tangible presence.
